## How To Get Emergency Food from a Pantry

**Find your local pantry:** Find the pantry closest to your home by visiting [TinyURL.com/FFLCPantryMap](http://TinyURL.com/FFLCPantryMap), or calling FOOD for Lane County at (541) 343-2822. Para información en español, llame a FOOD for Lane County: 541-343-2822.

**Make sure you income qualify:** To access an emergency food pantry your household income must be at or below 185% of the federal poverty level. Refer to the chart at the right.

**You will not need to show any identification to access food from a Lane County pantry.** Some of our partner agencies provide other services and may require other documentation for those services, but never to receive food.

**Bring boxes/bags:** Please make sure to bring enough bags or boxes to take your food with you. You will be able to receive a 3-5 day supply of food for your household.

**You may have to wait:** Sometimes lines can be long. Get to know your home pantry system and personnel to best understand how each pantry works.

**You are welcome to get involved:** Many pantries would love your help. Ask personnel if they are looking for volunteers - it's a great way to give back!
